Food insecurity means that those families do not have enough food for every family member in the home to lead a healthy life.



Hearts Against Hunger provides weekend meals and snacks in reusable bags on Friday afternoons to the students. Families may also choose to receive food boxes during school breaks. Participation is voluntary, confidential and coordinated through the counselor.

To sign up, families need to complete the Hearts Against Hunger application form and return it to the school counselor. Families can remove themselves at any time.
